**PERMITS:** Koylton Twp is a zoned township. Zoning permits are required for construction projects within the township. Some examples include pole barns, dwellings, decks, portable structures, electrical service, and the demolition of structures. **Zoning permits are required before you start your project.** If the project is started prior to obtaining a permit you may be subject to additional costs for the permit. **TAX PAYMENTS: WINTER TAX IS DUE 2/28/2024- NO LATE TAXES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Tax payments may be dropped off at Tri-County Bank in Kingston and you can use the night deposit. You may mail your payments to PO Box 127 Kingston, MI 48741. Payments WILL NOT be accepted at the Treasurer Residence. **\*\*The Board adopted a policy that payments will be posted the day they are received, not the postmark date. Please take this into consideration when mailing your tax payments close to due date. IF at all possible drop them at Tri-County either through the window or night drop.**

**FIRE RUNS:** A Fire Run can run up to \$1500 for the first hour and additional costs for every hour thereafter. Residents should check with their insurance company to ensure that they have sufficient coverage in the event of a fire.

***Any resident looking to serve their community, all of our fire departments are looking for members. Contact your local fire department if you are interested.***

**GARBAGE PICK UP:** GFL Environmental is the Koylton Township Garbage Service. Garbage Pick-up is on Monday with holidays listed on their website. Residents in Koylton Township have garbage pickup; your payment is assessed on your Winter Taxes. **Even if you are tax exempt you will be assessed and are still required to pay your garbage bill in the Winter.**
