

**April 14, 2022**  
**Koylton Twp Board Meeting**

**APPROVED**

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:05 pm.  
Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Boyl, Sabin and Blonde.  
4 township residents present and 1 guest.

Motion made by Sabin, seconded by Boyl to approve the minutes of March 10, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Sabin to approve the Treasurer's report for April 2022 with an ending balance of \$58,284.63 with additional funds to transfer later from Tax Fund Account. Motion carried.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Boyl to approve and sign the proposed road work contracts for 2022 and pay the half down deposit of \$67,862.50 for the following gravel roads:  
Phillips Rd from Mayville Rd to Marlette Rd  
Marlette Rd from Jefferson to Phillips Rd ¼ mile  
English Rd from Mayville Rd to Marlette Rd  
Harris Rd from White Creek Rd to Koylette Rd  
Denhoff Rd from Kingston Rd to Cemetery Rd  
Centerline Rd from Kingston Rd to Cemetery Rd  
Motion carried.

Kramer presented the engineering bids for Livermore Rd for review and discussion. The board agreed to direct Kramer to go back to the road commission to try and negotiate favorable terms for road work construction on Livermore Rd.

**Public Comment:**

Brent Robinson from Paramount Dairy, guest and property owner on Marlette Rd west of Phillips Rd stated future plans for the acreage with young cattle barns and crops. He would like the township to apply for road abandonment with the Road Commission of the east ¾ mile of Marlette Rd between English Rd to Phillips Rd. Also, he is willing to enter a Hauling Agreement to assist in maintenance of Marlette Rd between Phillips Rd to Kingston Rd.

Questions and discussion followed.

Kramer presented to the board the procedures he had received from the road commission regarding road abandonment and Hauling Agreement.

The board agreed to start the process of road abandonment and Hauling Agreement by directing Kramer to notify the road commission by letter of the Townships intent on the abandonment of the east ¾ mile of Marlette Rd between English Rd to Phillips Rd and Hauling Agreement between Phillips Rd to Kingston Rd.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Blonde to approve and adopt the new 2022 Federal and State Poverty Exemption Guidelines MCL 211.7u (1) and to set a \$50,000 maximum other asset amount limit apart from the persons principal residence. Motion carried.

Kramer mentioned that the Board of Review two days went well and that he had to find an alternate for one day as Sharon Klawender was unavailable for 1 day. He was able to get Lisa Fox as alternate for 1 day. Thank you for your service.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Sabin to approve and pay up to \$275 for MTA online training classes for Shari Blonde, Treasurer. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyl, seconded by Vroman to accept the contract for brining of township gravel roads from Wilkinson Solutions and pay the deposit of \$3,560. Motion carried.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Boyl to adopt the Garbage Collection Budget for 2022-2023 for \$120,301.50 which includes a fuel adjustment surcharge. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Blonde to adopt the 2022-2023 township working budget of \$661,000.00. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Vroman to pay township bills of \$92,321.10 for April 2022. Motion carried.
