Koylton Township Board Meeting

The Regular Koylton Township Board Meeting was called to order by Supervisor Justin Boyl @ 7:00 pm. Pledge to the flag. Board Members present: J. Boyl, Kelly, S. Boyl, Hubbard and Sabin.

10 others were present.

Motion made by J. Boyl, seconded by S. Boyl to accept the Meeting Agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kelly, seconded by Hubbard to approve the minutes of the November 14, 2024 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Hubbard, seconded by Sabin to accept the Treasurer's report with an ending balance in the general fund of \$213,118.88. Motion carried.

Public Comment:

John Adams discussed drain issues at the Southwest corner of Lanway/Clothier causing ponding of water with no flow.

Gary Seldon discussed road issues on Clothier Rd between Centerline & Harris. Photos were provided. Road looks to need a top base.

Rod Chappel discussed a culvert issue at the Centerline & Cemetery intersection, westside headed east on Centerline. All water flows south reaches culvert but doesn't flow through it.

Motion made by Hubbard, seconded by S. Boyl to approve land combination of 2 – 5 acre parcels for Huimin Guan on Lanway Rd, Clifford. Parcel #016-029-000-1300-05 and Parcel #016-029-000-1300-06. Motion carried.

Supervisor's Report:

J. Boyl met w/Road Commission. County will be spraying this year. After being sprayed they will come back and cut back the dead stuff. An opt out method will be provided if you don't want spraying done. There will still be some discussion on pricing and about the \$25,000 allowance given by the County. Kappen Tree Service has about 1 – 1 ½ miles left to finish on White Creek Rd and will discuss with them pricing to trim Clothier Rd.

Motion made by Kelly, seconded by Hubbard to turn down the Economic Development that was presented. Motion carried.

Effective 12/12/2024 Ashley Schank resigned as CCO. J. Boyl and Hubbard will oversee the CCO duties until the position is filled.

Motion made by S. Boyl, seconded by Hubbard to adopt resolution #2024-12 "Resolution Regarding American Rescue Plan Act Funds". Motion carried.

Motion made by S. Boyl, seconded by Kelly to approve moving the Covid Relief money back into a 3 month CD and issue cashiers check after to pay on Drains.

S. Boyl stated that Scott Boden from GFL has retired and she is currently communicating with Jodi in the Brown City office until given updated contact information. She has also updated GFL with the current number of residents in the township.

Winter Tax Bills have been sent. Koylton Township collects Winter Taxes until February 28, 2025.

CCO Report:

No funds and No permits issued.
