

January 13, 2022
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:03 pm. Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Boyd, Sabin, Blonde
4 other township resident present and 1 visitor.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Sabin to approve the minutes of December 9, 2021 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Sabin to approve the Treasurer's report for January 2022 with an ending balance of \$123,163.94. Motion carried.

Public Comments:

Jim Borek questioned what the Deputy Treasurer was doing to have so many hours each month. Blonde replied that last month included having to stuff and mail two sets of winter tax bills due to error on the first bill.

Supervisor Kramer stated that he contacted consultant David Sernick who is assisting Tuscola County in regard to managing and planning the use of funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). He said that there is no plan or organization of coordinating any county wide use and is trying to figure out the recent Final Rule published by the government.

Kramer stated that the Final Rule establishes four general uses for funds:

1. Replacing Lost Public Sector Revenue
2. Public Health and Economic Impacts
3. Premium Pay for Essential Workers
4. Water, Sewer and Broadband Infrastructure

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Boyd to accept the verbal resignation of Sarah Kinel as member of Board of Review. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Sabin to fill the vacancy spot on Board of Review with Christine Harneck. Motion carried.

Kramer presented information received from the county regarding the topic of marijuana grow operations and how it needs to be addressed within our local government. Sample ordinances, articles and opinions were included. Information passed on to the planning commission.

Discussion by the board regarding the Wilkinson Corporation brining contract received for 2022 summer season. Discount price good to April 1, 2022. No action taken at this time.

Kramer had a copy of the Notice of Electrical Ordinance posting which was reviewed and discussion of wording changes for the upcoming hearing next week Thursday.

Vroman stated that he received a letter from the county road commission informing the township of the retirement of Superintendent Jay Tuckey and replacement of new Superintendent/Operations Manager to be Jason Root.

Jim Borek asked about roads: Livermore Rd and Phillips Rd from Mayville Rd south to Marlette Rd. Kramer stated that there would be further discussion of road work at the annual meeting.

Vroman mentioned the Marlette Fire Authority upcoming meeting and annual budget review scheduled for February 22, 2022 at 6:30 at the fire hall in Marlette.

Vroman stated that the mileage reimbursement rate established for 2022 by the IRS is 58.5 cents per mile.

Vroman mentioned that the Michigan Independent Citizen Redistricting Commission has adopted the maps for the district lines of Congressional, Senate and House seats which will affect our local district representation requiring new voter ID cards being printed and mailed which will be done by Spectrum Printers at a cost to the township.

Vroman mentioned the upcoming notice of hearing for SEMCO Energy Gas Company held by Video/Teleconferencing Wednesday, January 26, 2022 at 9:00 am. Those interested in participating call 517-284-8090.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Kramer to approve land division request for Carl Silvernail parcels ID #016-003-000-0100-10 & #016-003-000-0100-12 boundary line adjustments and combination creating a new 2.892 acre parcel. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyl, seconded by Blonde to approve land division request for Carl Silvernail parcel ID #016-003-000-0100-13 & part of parcels ID #016-003-000-0100-10 & #016-003-000-0100-12 boundary line adjustments creating two new parcels. Motion carried.

Motion made by Sabin, seconded by Kramer to approve land division request for Carl Silvernail part of parcels ID #016-003-000-0100-14 & #016-003-000-0100-13 boundary line adjustments and combination creating two new parcels 5+ acres and remaining flag lot parcel. Motion carried.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Boyl to approve land division request for Rex Vroman parcels ID #016-028-000-0100-01 & 016-028-000-0100-02 boundary line adjustments and combination creating two new parcels 15.06 acres and 8.02 acre flag lot parcel. Vroman abstained from voting. Motion carried.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Kramer to pay township bills of \$23,842.69 for January 2022. Motion carried.
