

July 12, 2018
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:01 pm.

Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Jobson, Boyl and Thom.
14 other township residents present along with Kim Vaughn, county commissioner.

Motion made by Jobson, seconded by Boyl to approve the minutes of June 14th, 2018 meeting with correction to read \$125/hour instead of \$25/hour for brush removal. Motion carried.

Motion made by Thom, seconded by Boyl to approve the Treasurer's report for July 2018 with an ending balance of \$204,641.11. Motion carried.

Thom updated board regarding quotes for roadside brush removal from Kappen Tree Service at \$100.00/hour. Also the 2 miles west of Kingston Rd on Mayville Road was discussed in need of brush removal. Roadside spraying was also discussed with no action taken.

Motion made by Thom, seconded by Boyl to amend last months motion regarding roadside brush removal contract to be with Contractor of Choice up to \$5,000 for roadside brush removal starting with 2 miles of Cemetery Road between Denhoff & Brief Rds and between Centerline & Harris Rds. Then 1 mile of Cartwright Road between Kingston & Cemetery Rds. Motion carried.

Discussion regarding roadside line painting of White Creek road at \$600 per mile no action taken waiting until the chip and seal is completed. Also discussion regarding last year road contract for gravel which has not be completed, asked Kim Vaughn to check into with road commission.

Public comment: Kim Vaughn, commissioner spoke about issues in Congress regarding role of Assessors/Assessing being at the county level instead of each township. Also, Tuscola County Animal Shelter is open with a new kennel attendant. Discussion at county commissioner level about a proposal of a County Land Bank, similar function as the Michigan Land Bank.

Ron Colton commented on the Marlette Fire Authority Quarterly meeting to be held Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 6:30 to discuss building repairs and options.

Public discussion regarding obtaining copies of the Renewable Energy Ordinance that was passed.

There were township residents present that voiced their complaint regarding noise level coming from Log-N-Iron Sawmill located at 5225 Kingston Road.

Vroman passed out copies of the Annual Audit completed by King and King, CPAs LLC to board members for review and discussion at next month's board meeting.

Motion by Kramer, seconded by Jobson to pay township bills of \$23,643.41 which includes a bank debit of \$55.12 for checks for the July 2018 expenses. Motion carried.
