

July 14, 2022
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

APPROVED

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:00 pm.
Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Blonde, Boyl and Sabin.
4 other township residents present.

Motion made by Boyl, seconded by Sabin to approve the minutes of the June 9, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Sabin to approve the Treasurer's report for July 2022 with an ending balance of \$175,339.33. Motion carried.

Public Comment: None

Supervisors Comments:

Kramer noted that a letter was received from Burlington Township Fire Department Chief requesting that if Koylton Township has any available ARPA monies that if some can be contributed to the Burlington Fire Department for equipment that would better serve our community and that they would be grateful for it.

Kramer asked the board for some ideas and uses for the ARPA money received. Following are some uses mentioned:

- Updating the boards computers and technology.
- Local fire departments that service Koylton Township.
- Central location in the township for Tornado Siren.
- Road improvements, widening, brushwork.

Kramer mentioned that most of the roads contracted for gravel work this year with the county road commission have been done with exception of Denhoff Rd and Centerline Rd in the process. Kramer stated that the communication with the Road Commission has improved greatly.

Kramer said that the garbage collection complaints have declined and is getting better.

Kramer stated that the process of installing new culverts on Kingston Rd has started and that at this time there is no current plan by the road commission for new asphalt on the road.

Kramer said that the roadside mowing is done and has received comments that it looks good.

Kramer to get a quote from Discrete Diesel for brushwork on certain roads marked on a map where needed.

By board consensus permission was given to Kramer to contact Wilkinson Corp. for gravel road brining if needed.

Vroman stated that the mileage reimbursement rate established for 2022 by the IRS has increased from 58.5 cents per mile to 62.5 cents per mile beginning July 1 to December 31, 2022.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Blonde for Justin Boyl to be Doug Kramer's alternate for the Election Commission at the Public Accuracy Testing on July 18, 2022. Motion carried.

Vroman mentioned that at the county clerks meeting that it was stated that there is expected to be a lot of write ins for candidates on the primary ballots and that it may require duplicating of ballots. Also, that there may be more poll watchers and poll challengers. Kramer to provide a backup generator for the election if there is a power outage.

Blonde handed out a copy of the summer newsletter to all and said that it would be mailed with all of the paid tax receipts and placed on the township website.

Boyl provided all board members with a revised copy of the Draft Electrical Ordinance for their review so that action can be made at next month's meeting.

Boyl also mentioned that the Planning Commission is in the process of working on a shipping container ordinance, animal ordinance and camper ordinance.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Blonde to pay township bills of \$22,470.77 for July 2022. Motion carried.
