

May 12, 2022
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:00 pm.
Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Sabin, Blonde and Boyl.
1 township resident present and 1 guest.

Motion made by Sabin, seconded by Kramer to approve the minutes of April 14, 2022 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Sabin to approve the Treasurer's report for May 2022 with an ending balance of \$175,044.57. Motion carried.

Scott Bowden from GFL Environmental, the townships new garbage collection company presented some history of the company, day of collection on Monday and plans of recycling. He also stated that there would be a revision related to the energy/fuel price surcharge and presented an addendum to the current Residential solid waste agreement. The fuel cost will be based on the Department of Energy web site for Diesel #2 Midwest monthly average.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Vroman to accept and sign the addendum for fuel price surcharge to the Garbage solid waste agreement. Motion carried.

Kramer stated that he made contact with Evan Howard, (Howards Lawn and Snow) and that he will be mowing the Siple Cemetery again this year.

Kramer mentioned that he and Larry Sabin attended the Marlette Fire Authority meeting. Ron Coltson mentioned that the fire hall building repairs were complete except the doors.

Kramer mentioned that he and Larry Sabin attended the Supervisors meeting at the Road Commission and also met with the engineer road planner regarding options for Livermore Rd. Different ideas were discussed and then Kramer was to meet with Al Jacobs on Livermore Rd. After Kramer's meeting with Al Jacobs the road commission proposed that Ogden's mailbox be moved back, which Justin Boyl did with permission. Then the road commission will remove the brush along the north side of the hill and grade the area as road maintenance at no expense to the township.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Kramer for Resolution 2022-104 stating that the Koylton Township Board is in favor of reducing the speed limit to 45 mph beginning at Denhoff Road north to the Kingston Village limits posted 25 mph sign on Kingston Rd. Motion carried.

Kramer mentioned that the roads are scheduled to be graded and brined around Memorial Day.

Kramer stated that he contacted Steve Anderson, Tuscola County Emergency Manager regarding the County's Hazard Mitigation Plan and has agreed that Koylton Township will adopt the plan and participate by, #1 Test, expand, and update the current countywide warning system by informing and promoting township residents to sign up and create a Smart 911 profile. The Township will do this by the newsletter, website and posting on the message board.

Vroman presented an email to the board showing that he had successfully submitted the Project and Expenditure Report for the ARPA funds on April 18 prior to the deadline of April 30. Vroman also mentioned that due to statewide redistricting the new Voter ID cards projected mailing date is May 23, 2022.

Motion made by Boyl, seconded by Blonde to pay township bills of \$10,292.27 for May 2022.
