

May 9, 2019

Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:00 pm. Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Jobson, Boyl and Thom. 9 other township residents present.

Motion made by Boyl, seconded by Jobson to approve the minutes of April 11, 2019 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Thom to approve the Treasurer's report for May 2019 with an ending balance of \$246,155.82. Motion carried.

Public Comment:

Dr. Robbins voiced his concern regarding Cartwright Rd east of Kingston Rd, specifically the hill and width of the road by his driveway, saying that the roadside washes out and that it is dangerous and a safety issue. He was wondering what steps were being taken by the board to correct this situation. Supervisor Kramer stated that the board has addressed this concern with the road commission who will be inspecting the road and proposing a plan for road work.

Earl Bailey III submitted a zoning permit application with check to Supervisor Kramer to replace existing residence on his 20 acre parcel on the corner of Cemetery Rd and Denhoff Rd.

Ron Coltson commented that the Marlette Fire Department did purchase the used Ladder Fire Truck and that it is in the garage. Financing is with ELGA CU for 12 years at 4.2%. The other 3 trucks are for sale.

Supervisor Comments:

Kramer noted that he was uncertain as to the correct date for the tire collection at Dayton Township hall being on Friday, May 24, 2019 as it is usually on a Saturday. He said that was what was posted in the paper.

He read a notice from DTE regarding a hearing for rate increase on May 14 & 21 in Lansing. He also said that there are opt out forms for brush spraying available for any residents that request one.

Kramer stated that he has spoke with Rob St. George ZA and the local police officer, Al Pearsel about possibly taking over as ZA.

Kramer reported that he received a request from Stan Fox for the application and special land use permit for Log-N-Iron of which he gave him copies on April 29, 2019.

Much discussion regarding road work by board and residents.

Motion made by Thom, seconded by Vroman to direct Supervisor Kramer to ask for permits from the road commission to proceed with Albrecht Sand & Gravel to place 1000 ton of 23A at cost of 13.50 per ton (\$13,500) on Brief Rd between White Creek Rd to Marton Rd. Also, to place 500 ton of 23A at cost of \$6,750 on Denhoff Rd west of White Creek approximately a ¼ mile.

Amendment to motion to also include permit for Albrecht Sand & Gravel to place 1500 ton of 23A at cost of \$20,250 on Harris Rd between Cemetery Rd and Clothier Rd. Motion carried.

Motion made by Thom, seconded by Jobson to have Kramer submit work orders to road commission for road work on:

- 1) White Creek Rd between Centerline Rd to Harris Rd,
- 2) Mayville Rd between Kingston Rd to Cemetery Rd,

3) Cartwright Rd between Kingston Rd to Cemetery Rd,

4) Phillips Rd between Mayville Rd to Snover Rd.

Motion carried.

Motion made by Thom, seconded by Jobson that road work (i.e. scrub seal and 2 inches of asphalt cap) for White Creek Rd between Mayville Rd and Harris Rd proceed with work order contingent upon the road commission agreeing to carry the township for 1 year at 50% of total cost of \$170,000. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Boyl to waive the township's first right of refusal regarding tax foreclosed parcel #016-027-000-0200-00 on Lanway Rd. Motion carried.

Motion made by Jobson, seconded by Kramer to pay township bills of \$5,678.56 for May 2019. Motion carried.
