

November 11, 2021
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

APPROVED

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:00 pm. Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Boyd, Sabin, Blonde
2 other township residents present.

Kramer gave recognition for Veteran's Day honoring and remembering those who had served our country. Tribute to all military veterans, Thank you!

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Sabin to approve the minutes of October 14, 2021 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Kramer to approve the Treasurer's report for November 2021 with an ending balance of \$119,156.36. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Blonde to approve and sign the Right-of-Way Telecommunications Permit from Metro Act by TEC upon review and recommendation by the township attorney. Motion carried.

Supervisor's Report:

Kramer stated that the Road Commission repaired the asphalt that was breaking up on White Creek Rd caused by the heavy sugar beet hauling trucks at no cost to the township.

Kramer said that he was notified that Harris Rd also was getting torn up due to heavy beet hauling trucks so he contacted the Road Commission and they have graded the road two times since and the road is much better.

Kramer mentioned that he received a letter from the Road Commission asking that the township start thinking about what road projects the township wants to get completed in 2022. Discussion regarding roads will take place at the January 2022 regular township board meeting.

Kramer noted that the white fog lines on the 2 miles of Mayville Rd have been painted by the Road Commission.

Kramer stated that DTE Energy contacted him regarding a new electrical permit for a 300-amp service approved by the new building codes department for a parcel on Phillips Rd. DTE was wondering whether the township had approved it since we have a moratorium in place regarding service in excess of 200 amps. Kramer told them no we did not approve it and thanked them for the notice. Kramer then contacted the owner and told them that we currently have a 200-amp service limit and that the owner needs a land use permit.

Motion made by Blonde, seconded by Kramer to accept the revised and updated Zoning Land Use permit fee schedule and provide to Linda Borek for update to the Township website along with change of Mark Schank as the Code Compliance Officer. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Vroman to approve the revised and updated Code Compliance Zoning Permit Form and provide to Linda Borek for update to the Township website. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Blonde to approve land combination application for Foster & Melissa Findlay, parent parcels ID#016-036-000-1300-02 & ID#016-036-000-1300-03. Motion carried.

Vroman reported that there may be three elections for the township next year 2022.

Blonde mentioned that she received Drain at Large information increase for next year to be around \$29,302.71.

Boyd mentioned that the planning commission is ready to print the updated township master plan which has been reviewed and accepted by the Tuscola County Planning Commission. Also, the next planning commission meeting date is next week Thursday November 18th.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Blonde to pay township bills of \$11,727.66 for November 2021. Motion carried.
