Township Board- We have voted Justin Boyl to be on the township board as a replacement for Scott McCool. He was a member of the Planning Commisiion at one time so he does bring some township experience to the board.

Roads- All the road work has finally been done. There was some delay because all the crushed limestone was being used for the wind turbine construction. The county Road Commission has promised that all the roads will be graded before winter sets in and the roads get hard. The Asphalt work has been done on the apron of the bridge on White Creek Road.

Lanway Drain- This drain work has been completed but we do feel that the culvert that crosses Kingston Rd needs to be replaced.

Voters- We have over 1100 regisetred voters in our township. Voter turnout for Nov. elections was 450. It is a long day for the Election Officials but I really enjoy seeing all of you who do come in to vote. There was a man standing outside the polls doing a survey of some sort. There are rules in place for that and he was legal. That DOES NOT mean that you have to answer any of his questions.

Planning Commission- During the year of 2015, the Planning Commission will be reviewing the townships Master Plan. The Master Plan is simply a written plan for the future of our township. It is not rules or laws. The state asks that we review this every 5 years. If you have any ideas for the future of our township we would really like to hear from you. We know that road condition is very important to all of us, so that will continue to be dealt with. Some of the other concerns were slow growth, reasonable taxes, police and fire protection, farmland and employment opportunities.
