Residents in Koylton Township have garbage pickup; your payment is assessed on your Winter Taxes. Even if you are tax exempt you will be assessed and are still required to pay your garbage bill in the Winter.

PROPERTY TRANSFER AFFIDAVIT: Residents are required to turn in the Property Transfer Form 2766 to the assessor within 45 days of ownership.

Forms can be sought from Doug Kramer or Shari Blonde or found on the Koylton Township website.

PRIMARY RESIDENT EXEMPTION (PRE): PRE exempts a principal residence from the tax levied by a local school district for school operating purposes up to 18 mills. To qualify for a PRE on a parcel of land, a person must be a Michigan resident who owns and occupies the property as a principal residence. If Koylton Township is not your primary residence, you should submit a FORM 2602 Request to Rescind Principal Residence Exemption.

TAX PAYMENTS:

Tax payments may be dropped off at Tri-County Bank in Kingston or mail your payments to PO Box 127 Kingston, MI 48741. Payments WILL NOT be accepted at the Treasurer Residence.

Please allow 10-14 days. **The Board adopted a policy that payments will be posted the day they are received, not the postmark date. Please take this into consideration when mailing your tax payments close to due date. Regardless of where payment is made, a receipt will be mailed to you.
