

August 8, 2020
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 3:00 pm. Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Jobson, Sabin and Boyd. 1 other township resident present.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Sabin to approve the minutes of July 9, 2020 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Sabin, seconded by Kramer to approve the Treasurer's report for August 2020 with an ending balance of \$72,694.27. Motion carried.

Kramer stated that the Road Commission has started some road gravel projects on Harris Rd and hopefully get to Clothier Rd this next week. Kramer has been in contact with Al Jacobs from the road commission and Al has informed Kramer that there is not much gravel in stock and they are waiting for it to be processed due to the shut down for Covid-19.

Kramer noted that there was an accident on the corner of Koylette and Mayville Roads and that a resident of the township contacted him requesting a stop sign be installed at the corner. Kramer stated that they would need to get a petition signed by the residents and present it to the road commission. Not enough residents were interested in signing a petition to pursue the project.

There have been some concerns raised regarding zoning compliance blight issues and abandoned vehicles. Kramer has referred them to the CCO to investigate.

Kramer stated that the township received a fire run bill from Burlington Township for downed power lines causing a fire. He contacted Burlington Township Fire Chief to see if they had tried to collect from DTE first. They had not so they will try to collect from DTE now.

Motion made by Jobson, seconded by Boyd to approve the wording for the Koylton Township Proposal, Renewal for Improvement And Maintenance of Roads Proposition, thereby to place a 2 mill renewal for road improvement and maintenance proposal for 2 years (2021-2022) on the November ballot. Motion carried.

Kramer commented that he received notice of some roadsides that had not been mowed, so he contacted Nick Osentoski and gave him the list of roads to complete which he has done.

Kramer reported that there is ongoing discussion with the road commission and township as to the type of road work that needs to be done on Livermore Rd and the corner of Phillips and Marlette Road to correct some problems.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Jobson to approve five parcels of agricultural land for Michael Fischer to be placed into PA116. Numbered as: PA116-2020-01 Tax ID #016-026-000-1400-05, PA116-2020-02 Tax ID #016-024-000-1800-01, PA116-2020-03 Tax ID #016-023-000-0700-00, PA116-2020-04 Tax ID #016-013-000-0300-02, PA116-2020-05 Tax ID #016-024-000-1800-04. Motion carried.

Vroman reported that the August 4th Primary Election overall went well with a good turnout and doubled increase of AV ballots. The Koylton Township, Improvement And Maintenance of Roads Renewal Proposal on the ballot passed by a good margin 245 yes votes and 78 no votes.

Boyl reported that the Planning Commission met and is working on updating the Master Plan for the Township. He also gave upcoming Planning Commission meeting dates, September 17th, 2020, October 22nd, 2020, and January 21st, 2021 all at 7:00 pm at the Village Hall.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Jobson to pay township bills of \$16,103.57 for August 2020. Motion carried.
