

July 9, 2020
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:00 pm. Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Jobson, Sabin and Boyd. 1 other township resident present.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Sabin to approve the minutes of June 11, 2020 meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman, seconded by Boyd to approve the Treasurer's report for July 2020 with an ending balance of \$88,369.83. Motion carried.

Kramer stated that the Road Commission has agreed to replace missing road name signs.

Boyd is working on getting someone to clean up the remaining pulp wood along roadsides from the tree and brush removal work that was done by Kappen Tree Service.

Kramer noted that there is an upcoming day of review of drainage district boundaries and review of apportionments for three County drains on July 22, 2020 from 9:00 am – 5:00 pm at the Tuscola County Drain Commissioner's Office, 125 W. Lincoln Street, Caro, MI or by remote access through Zoom for township residents impacted. The three drains are: 1) N. Br. Of the Flint River Intercounty Drain 2) Duff Intercounty Drain 3) Vining Intercounty Drain.

Kramer reported that he and the CCO met with the owners of the Joy for Jesus camp on Kingston Road about zoning change. They referred them to the planning commission.

Kramer stated that the Board of Review for July will meet July 21st at 5:00 to review any property tax corrections, changes or mistakes and that the appeal process for tax assessments was also extended due to Covid 19.

Motion made by Boyd, seconded by Jobson to increase Assessors salary by \$50 more per month for the remaining fiscal year of 2020-2021. Motion carried.

Kramer read a note received from Jim Borek regarding certain roads needing attention, the hill on Livermore Rd and Phillips Rd south of Mayville Rd. Kramer is going to contact the road commission for grading and repair. Also, discussion about roadside mowing, maps of roads and double cut on corners.

Discussion by the board regarding posting the treasurers report on the website. Board agreed that they feel that it is not necessary at this time.

Boyd reported that he has contacted the State department for licensing and regulation of marijuana growing operations and that no one in the township has applied for or received a license or permit. He stated that it is legal for a person to grown up to 12 plants and that they are to be fenced and not visible to the public. Kramer said that he spoke with the township attorney and the attorney stated that our current ordinance is fine and would restrict large growing operations. Suspicious activity should be reported to the Police to investigate.

Motion made by Kramer, seconded by Boyd to pay township bills of \$22,038.29 for July 2020. Motion carried.
