

November 14, 2019
Koylton Twp Board Meeting

The regular Koylton Twp meeting was called to order by Supervisor Doug Kramer at 7:00 p.m. Pledge to the Flag. Board Members present: Kramer, Vroman, Jobson, Boyl, Sabin. 10 other township residents present.

Motion made by Jobson, seconded by Kramer to approve the minutes of the October 10, 2019 meeting with wording change of Zoning Administrator to Code Compliance Officer. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyl, seconded by Sabin to approve the Treasurer's report for November 2019 with an ending balance of \$67,766.40 with wording change from Sub-total to Total Income. Motion carried.

Kramer reported that a lawsuit has been filed by some township residents against Log-N-Iron Sawmill. The township received a subpoena requesting all documentation pertaining to Log-N-Iron special land use permit and the time involved collecting the paperwork. Kramer mentioned that some residents including himself would be giving depositions in the next couple weeks.

Kramer reported that Al Jacobs, foreman for the Road Commission inspected our township roads and provided a map with recommended crushed gravel repair work for next year. Resident Gary Seldon mentioned the condition of Clothier Rd between Harris to Centerline Rd. The following roads were discussed for road work next year per map provided.

- Clothier Rd – Harris Rd to Centerline Rd
- Phillips Rd – patching by Birch Drive
- English Rd – patching Livermore Rd to Snover Rd.
- Cemetery Rd – Denhoff Rd to Brief Rd
- Cemetery Rd – Brief Rd to Cartwright Rd
- Denhoff Rd – ½ mile between Clothier Rd and White Creek Rd
- Harris Rd – White Creek Rd to Koylette Rd
- Clothier Rd – Mayville Rd to Marlette Rd

Discussion regarding Tire collection in the township next summer. Consensus was to pass on it this year.

Motion made by Vroman seconded by Kramer to approve land division application for owner Norbert James Ogden, applicant Elliot Michael Hubbard, parent parcels #016-019-000-0200-01 & 016-019-000-0200-02 into three new parcels. Motion carried.

Motion made by Jobson seconded by Boyl to approve land division application for owners Kyle & Kurt Thom, parent parcel #016-015-000-2600-00. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyl seconded by Sabin to approve land division application for owner Theodorus Van Rijn, applicant Jerry Papke, parent parcel #016-016-000-0100-04. Motion carried.

Ron Coltson reported that the Marlette Fire Department sold the Ambulance but the pumper truck was declined.

Terrie Flikkie, Planning Commission Chairperson presented to the board the details of the Land use by Special Permit hearing held October 30, 2019 for Amy & Ben King to open a Craft Store, 'Amy's Country Crafts' on their property with size of sign to be changed. Planning commission vote 4 yays, 0 nays for recommendation to the board for approval.

Motion made by Kramer seconded by Jobson to approve Land Use by Special Permit for Amy & Ben King to operate a Craft store/Antiques, parent parcel #016-034-000-1850-00. Motion carried.

Motion made by Vroman seconded by Boyl to move \$2,000 from the Contingency Fund to the Computer fund. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kramer seconded by Boyl to appoint Rod Friday Jr. to fill the vacancy on the planning Commission board. Motion carried.

Motion made by Sabin, seconded by Boyl to pay township bills of \$7,120.13 for November 2019. Motion carried.
